Please note that following a decision aimed at respecting the limits of the publication, some subjects such as monument inscriptions, genealogies, registers (baptism, marriage, burial) have been removed. From now on, these data mentioned under the "Sources" section will not be available anymore.

Introduction:

Dans chaque section, les ouvrages sont présentés par ordre alphabétique d'auteurs, sauf dans les sections 5, 6 et 8 où ils sont classés selon l'ordre alphabétique du sujet (en caractères gras), i.e., les confessions, les histoires régionales et les biographies. Le titre des ouvrages n'est pas répété mais au début de chaque section, le symbole utilisé «VA = voir aussi» renvoie aux titres qui figurent sous d'autres rubriques.

Within each section, references are set out in alphabetical order under the name of the author. In sections 5, 6, and 8, however, the arrangement is alphabetical by subject (in bold characters), i.e., communions, regional history and biography. Items are not repeated, but at the beginning of each section, references are given to relevant items in earlier or later sections by using the symbol "SA=see also".
